Due to acute blood loss, coded with 2851, also defined as normocytic, or normochromic anemia. Blood loss anemia is either chronic or acute. Anemia due to blood loss is a very common finding in the setting of general practice. Treatment of anemia will depend on the diagnosed cause.
