Individuals with sickle cell trait generally have no symptoms. It can cause bouts of "sickle pain" that may be abated with medical marijuana. Others have very severe symptoms and often are hospitalized for treatment. Sickle cell disease is present at birth, but most infants don't show any signs until they are more than 4 months old. People with sickle cell anemia usually have no ocular symptoms; however, when the disease affects the eyes, patients may have decreased vision, flashes and floaters.
